Kakisiwew School is pre-Kindergarten to Grade 12 with approximately 260 students and 40 dedicated staff. We are an active community. PURPOSE OF POSITION

Ochapowace Nation is looking for two full-time Elementary teachers to join our team for the 2025-2026 academic year. The incumbents will work closely with the principal to promote a safe and welcoming learning environment for all students.
