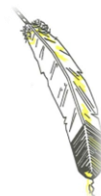

JOB SUMMARY

The Journeyman Carpenter performs a variety of tasks for the upcoming construction on Ochapowace. Under the guidance of the housing construction supervisor, the employee will follow the instructions given as to the duties and guidelines for the areas that he/she are building.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Constructs, installs, maintains, and repairs wooden structures and fixtures according to blueprints and plans for residential, commercial, and industrial projects,
- Fabricate, cut and install various components, including concrete forms, wooden frameworks (studding, walls, floors), stairs, doors and window frames.
- Inspect, repair and replace damaged wood structures and fixtures to maintain building integrity,
- Perform trim, finishing and detail work to complete structures,
- Clean, maintain, store and properly use a variety of hand and power tools, as well as specialized machinery,
- Determine and acquire the necessary lumber, hardware and other construction materials needed for projects,
- The duties may include cleaning and preparing a job site, loading and delivering materials,
- Removing debris from sites and using a variety of tools and machines such as power drills, levels, lifts saws, grinders, pressure washers,
- Setting up scaffolds and other temporary structures.
- They also assist other carpenters, masons, and other specialized contractors.

SKILLS, QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPETENCIES

- Grade twelve diploma or equivalent, related experience and/or a combination of apprentice or formal training is an asset,
- Must have physical strength, hand-eye coordination and endurance,
- Ability to perform measurements and calculations accurately,
