

JOB SUMMARY

Kitchen Supervisor is responsible for preparing/ cooking the menu items for guests in a timely manner, order any inventory that is low or needs replenishing, adhere to safety procedures, work as team, handle kitchen equipment and appliances, perform opening and closing of the restaurant, daily deposits/ receipts to the finance department, directing of all restaurant/ concession staff, organize and communicate effectively with co-workers and multiplex manager, assist in training new employees, maintain a clean kitchen, follow the Canada Food and health regulations and guidelines, Accounting for the daily billings for the hall and meeting room/ group events, perform additional tasks required.
