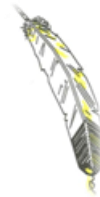

JOB SUMMARY

The Journeyman Plumber performs a variety of tasks for the upcoming construction and maintenance on Ochapowace. Under the guidance of the housing supervisor, the employee will follow the instructions given as to the duties and guidelines for the areas that he/she are responsible.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assembling and installing plumbing, drainage and gas systems according to blueprints, drawings and specifications,
- Performing routine inspections and preventative maintenance on plumbing fixtures and systems,
- Diagnosing and repairing leaks, blockages and malfunctioning fixtures, pipes and water heaters,
- Ensuring all work, installations and repairs meet local and provincial safety and plumbing codes,
- Testing new and repaired pipes for leaks using air and water pressure gauges,
- Providing guidance and oversight to apprentice plumbers, if applicable.

SKILLS, QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPETENCIES

- Grade twelve diploma or equivalent, related experience and/or a combination of apprentice or formal training is an asset,
- Ability to interpret technical drawings to understand system layouts,
- Expertise in using hand and power tools for cutting, bending, threading and joining pipes,
